



JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION: Landscape Equipment Operator

REPORTS TO: Superintendent and/or Foreman

PURPOSE: Operate assigned equipment in a proper, efficient, and safe manner. We are looking for individuals who are willing to work hard, enjoy working outside, and have knowledge of construction techniques and safety practices.

PHYSICAL JOB TASK REQUIREMENTS:

1. Lift & carry 50-100 lb. loads.
2. Be able to perform physical work (lifting, bending & kneeling, etc.) on uneven ground or slopes for entire work shift.
3. Perform physical work in all weather and site conditions from wet and cold (below freezing) to sunny and hot (over 100 degrees) for entire work shift.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Operate each piece of equipment in a proper & safe manner to complete the required work. Be aware of anyone in the vicinity of the equipment and do not put them in any danger. Remain within the limitations of the specific piece of equipment.
2. Report to the assigned project at the scheduled time with the required PPE including hard hat; safety vest; safety glasses; work boots and work gloves. Notify the Company immediately in the case of any tardiness or absence.
3. Follow the required maintenance procedures for each piece of equipment operated, and only perform maintenance as authorized by the Superintendent or Foreman. Report any equipment problems or concerns, immediately, to the Superintendent.
4. Check all equipment fluids to assure they are at the required levels **prior to operating any piece of equipment**. Only fill with specified fluids. Periodically check these levels while operating equipment.
5. Only operate the equipment you have been authorized to operate by Superintendent or Foreman.
6. Maintain RBI, Inc. quality standards for the project.
7. Observe all project safety practices. Report all accidents, injuries, and work related illnesses, immediately, to the project Superintendent.
8. Perform Laborer tasks and other duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:

1. Extensive knowledge of proper equipment operation and maintenance.
2. Knowledge of the limitations of various types of construction equipment.
3. The ability to read and understand blueprints and operate equipment to achieve the desired results.
4. Good verbal and written communication skills.
5. Good interpersonal skills
